Larry Warren, manager for the Kroger Marketplace, was present to address any questions or concerns. He noted that this wine tasting will be held in the conference room of the marketplace and will be mainly to display the store's various cheeses and hors d'oeuvre offered.

Mrs. Benson made a motion, seconded by Mr. Heron, to approve the request as submitted. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

#### Other:

Mr. Langeliers pointed out to the Board that he has been asked several times about the possibility of a liquor store in the Town, so he suggested counsel research the relating State laws. The Board was in agreement with Staff.
