Call to Order:

Utility Board Members and staff attending the meeting were: Chairman Jeff Risden, Alderman Brian Stover, Utility Board Members Skip Beasley, Bruce Difrancisco, Joshua Mayo, Charles Starck, Town Administrator Ken McLawhon, Finance Director Steve Banks, Wastewater Operator Brandon Haskins, Town Clerk Regina Fowler, and Town Attorney Kirk Vandivort. Wastewater Operator Kenny Bond was absent.

Minutes:

- 1. Consideration of the minutes of the April 20, 2022, regular meeting was presented: Mr. Skip Beasley made a motion to approve the April 20, 2022, regular meeting minutes. The motion was seconded by Bruce Difrancisco and carried unanimously.
- **2.** System Operators Update- Brandon Haskins: This month's report is consistent with last month's report. Output was 12,200,000 and input was 13,600,00. Normal maintenance has been completed. Cell 1 is 6" 8" of the aerators showing, Cell 2 is 1.5' below the top half of the effluent pipe. The new drip fields are doing fairly well, having issues with trapped air when shutting down. We are maintaining a good balance on everything. Kenny is able to perform some duties remotely.
- 3. Consideration for Briarhill Subdivision to connect to on-site sewer system located at Littlebury TDEC SOP No 18015 Modification: Josh Denton representing Levi Grantham presented information to the UB Board for consideration of Briarhilll Subdivision to connect to on-site sewer system located at Littlebury. The UB Board stated this was not their responsibility to address issues for consideration. The UB Board advised Mr. Denton/Levi Grantham to work with the Planning Commission and BOMA. Chairman Risden mentioned they might want to submit an application to the Town for connectivity to the regional plant.

 - Developer recently updated staking at site for Church's review

Regional Plant Project Update


- FNSI comment period completed with no comments.
